The traditional form of land consolidation is rapidly changing into an instrument for developing rural and peri-urban lands according to the objectives of spatial planning. Also a wider use of land consolidation is observed, for example to reduce the negative effects of highway- and railroad construction. As land consolidation is based on legal prescriptions, also laws are under revision. In France these development appear to be quite substantial.

The symposium will look after the French vision to the future of land consolidation, and will also deal with the developments in other European countries in order to be able to enter some comparative environment and to get a clear picture about the future of land consolidation.

Speakers who are already committed are Prof Arvo Vitikainen (Finland) with an overview over the status in Europe, Dr. Terry van Dijk (Netherlands) with an overview over land fragmentation in Europe and the future of programme based land consolidation, Mr. Gérard Reigner (France) with the current procedures in France, Mr. Rober Berges (France) with the future development in France, and country related visions of Mr. András Osskó (Hungary), prof. Joachim Thomas (Germany), Mr. Tommy Österberg (Sweden) and Mr. Mikko Uimonen (Finland).
